## Scholarship for international students: Georgius-Agricola-Wirtschaftsstipendium

The Georgius-Agricola scholarships are provided by the Saxon State Ministry for Science, Culture and Tourism (SMWK) to support recruitment of skilled workers and young managers in science, business and society in the Free State of Saxony. The target group for the Georgius-Agricola-Wirtschaftsstipendium is international students of the Leipzig University who undergo an internship in a company in Saxony. The internship can be a part of the studies (obligatory internship) or an independent internship which however is connected to the degree program. International students from all countries and degree programs can apply for it.

Funding amount:	150 EUR per month	
Duration:	October to December 2024 From 4 weeks to max. 3 months within this period	
Application deadline:	For scholarship starting from October: For scholarship starting from November:	31.10.2024. 13.11.2024.
	Applications are processed on a rolling basis.	

## **Requirements:**

- You are an international student at the Leipzig University (with the status according to §16 AufenthG)
- Your internship takes place in Saxony between October December (min. 4 weeks; the internship can exceed this time period)
- You are fully enrolled and are not in a semester leave
- You have (very) good grades
- Your internship company pays additional min. 150 EUR per month

## Documents:

- Current enrolment certificate
- Internship contract

The contract should state the start and end dates of the internship, the place of work and the remuneration. If the remuneration is not stated in the contract, a written confirmation from the company regarding the amount of the internship remuneration (at least 150 EUR) must also be submitted.

- German language certificate (min. A1)
- Transcript of records

You can receive this from your examination office. You can also submit a transcript of records from AlmaWeb, provided that your previous grades have been fully recorded there.

- Copy of a passport and a residence permit
- CV (tabular format; max. two pages)
